It's Official! Our 65<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration Tour; September 11 to 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019 will be held at the fabulous Point Lookout in Northport, ME.

We arrive on Wednesday at 3:00 P.M. Registration will be open from 3:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. After we get settled into our cabins, we will meet up for a fun evening at the Bowling Center. We will have a casual dinner followed by some friendly bowling competitions.

Thursday we begin our day with a grab and go style breakfast We will be traveling to see some unique Restoration shops and car collections, an unusual General Store filled with all kinds of antique tools. There are three floors so bring your lists of needs. Upon our return, we will enjoy a traditional New England Lobster dinner



Friday after breakfast we are off to Museum and other unique sites. Our journey will also take us to Fort Knox State Park or Fort Knox State Historic Site, which is located on the western bank of the Penobscot River in the town of Prospect, Maine, about 5 miles from the mouth of the river. Built between 1844 and 1869, it was the first fort in Maine built entirely of granite; most previous forts used wood, earth, and stone. It is named after Major General Henry Knox, the first U.S. Secretary of War and Commander of Artillery during the American Revolutionary War.



Those who wish to venture around the area may enjoy visiting the Chicken Barn. As the name suggests, the Big Chicken Barn is housed in a large relic of the golden age of Maine poultry farming. The ground floor is packed with over 21,000 sq. ft. from discontinued Down east industries. The second floor is a smorgasbord of books and periodicals. There are plenty of couches and chairs to rest in while you read and the coffee and tea pots are always on to enjoy a cup while relaxing.

Saturday begins with breakfast then we drive a coastal route to another unique antique barn, then onto Owls Head Transportation Museum. The **Owls Head Transportation Museum** has one of the finest collections of pioneer-era aircraft and automobiles in the world. More than 100 historic aircraft, automobiles, bicycles, carriages and engines are on permanent display. Lunch will be on your own and there are plenty of unique roadside deli's to choose from. Rockland also is home the famous Farnsworth Museum which features many Wyeth paintings and Jamie Wyeth's train collection. There are several antique shops on the routes.

We will return to Point Lookout for our final gathering to celebrate the New England Region's 65th Anniversary.
